- 1** Know your full name, your parents' names, your address and phone number.
- 2** Know how and when to use 9-1-1 or 0. Dialing these numbers for an emergency is always free!
- 3** Never put personal information on clothes, jewelry, hats or other belongings where strangers can see it.
- 4** Always Do Tell parents or other Trusted Adults about things that are scary, uncomfortable or sad.
- 5** A surprise is fun to keep, like a surprise party or a gift for Mom or Dad. A secret can feel bad to keep, and is always important to share with parents or other Trusted Adults.

Before I left my house, my Mother and I discussed how I could stay safe if I got separated from my friends. I remembered what Safety Kid said about Safe Helpers and who they were – a cashier, a person in uniform like a policeman or security guard, and the safest one was a mom-with-children. So my Mom and I made a card with her phone numbers on it and I put it into my shoe. Sure enough, I got separated from my friend and his Mom. I stayed calm and found another mom-with-children nearby, asking if I could use her cell phone. I called my Mother, who called my friend's mom, and she found me right where I got lost. Thank you, Safety Kid!



WHAT WOULD YOU DO?

1. Chani and Miriam wanted to play in Chani's front yard. There were some Safety Tips that they learned from Safety Kid. What did they need to do?

2. A car stops in front of Moshe's house while he was playing outside. The person in the car tries to get his attention to ask him a question. What should Moshe do?



Answers: 1. Tell their parents or other Trusted Adult in charge where they will be, and then stay in the yard while playing.
2. Go inside the house right away and tell his parents or other Trusted Adult in charge.
